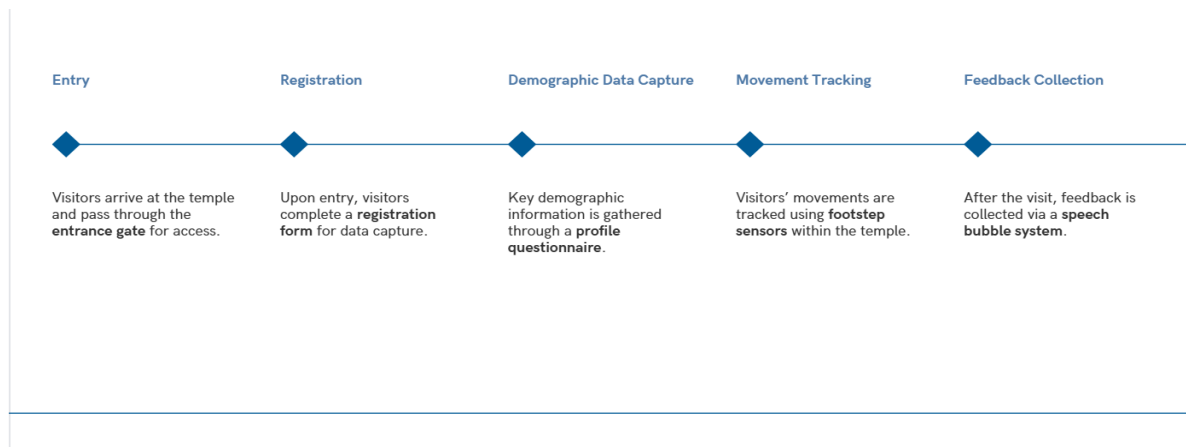


Fig 2. diagram of the data collection
