METHODS; -

Non experimental, descriptive research design was used for this study. 30 workers were selected through convenient sampling technique according to inclusion & amp; exclusion criteria who are working in the ACON HEALTH CARE PVT LTD, Lucknow.

A structured questionnaire was used to assess the knowledge of workers in the selected factory regarding occupational hazards and prevention of occupational hazards.

RESULTS -

In knowledge score test, almost workers in the selected factory had Mild knowledge in the area of occupational hazards (73.33%) and moderate knowledge in the area of prevention of occupational hazards (50%). The result revealed that mean value of knowledge scores is m = 12.20, SD = 4.38 Chi-square
